

The Golf Tournament Experience

The Tee-Off for Kids Classic is the Southwest Sports and Fitness Alliance's (SSFA) annual golf tournament to support sports-based youth development and recreational opportunities in Southwest Baltimore and beyond.

The Tournament is scheduled for Saturday, July 27, 2024, with a shotgun start at 8:00 AM at the 9-Hole Carroll Park Golf Course, 2100 Wahington Blvd., Baltimore, MD 21230.

The tournament will be a FUN event featuring foursomes of seasoned golfers as well as some comprised of experienced golfers and first-timers.

Registration/Sign-In begins at 7:00 AM. Raffle tickets and Mulligans will be sold. Golfers should be in their carts by 7:45 AM for announcements and instructions. Each cart will have an Instructions Page describing the exciting contests at several holes throughout the golf course and prizes to be awarded afterward. Any golfers arriving after the start will be shuttled to meet up with their foursome. Lunch is included in the \$70 fee and served after golfers are off the course and assembled for announcements regarding raffle and prize winners. Carry-out boxes will be available for golfers wishing to pack their lunch to-go.

Southwest Sports and Fitness Alliance (SSFA)

In 2018, a group of neighbors and friends started to meet and talk regularly about what could be done to ensure children and youth in Southwest Baltimore grow and develop healthier and have a clear pathway to a more productive and meaningful lifestyle. They wanted to create more opportunities for youngsters to gain confidence, be part of a positive peer culture, learn about teamwork, discipline, setting goals, and encounter supportive people and coaches at every turn.

Additional neighbors and friends were brought in to form a Board of Directors and a new not-for-profit 501(c)3 organization was formed. The vision was to use sports as a youth development strategy, create pathways and promising futures, and ensure that sports and recreation become an integral part of an opportunity-rich environment. Staff were hired and SSFA reached out to schools and committed leaders in the area who were engaging groups of children and youth in a variety of sports and recreational activities and "quietly" working with very limited resources. SSFA recruited teachers in each of the schools where it was providing after-school sports programs to serve as athletic coordinators and engage students, parents, administrators, and coaches who would introduce children to different sports throughout the year.

Five years after its inception, SSFA is slated to reopen the Poppleton Recreation Center, now undergoing a \$3 million renovation project, and provide additional programs for adults and seniors while instilling neighborhood pride in the community.
